

Florida State House of Representatives (2022) district 39 falls within Northeast Orange County. The northern boundary follows the Seminole/Orange County border. The western boundary follows the Lake/Orange County border, alongside the eastern shoreline of Lake Apopka and extends Northwest of Lake Ola. The southern boundary follows along the Florida Turnpike and extends north of Lake Sims to the Brevard/Orange County border. The eastern boundary runs parallel to sections of State Road 429 and extends to the Seminole/Orange County border west of the Wekiva River.
