

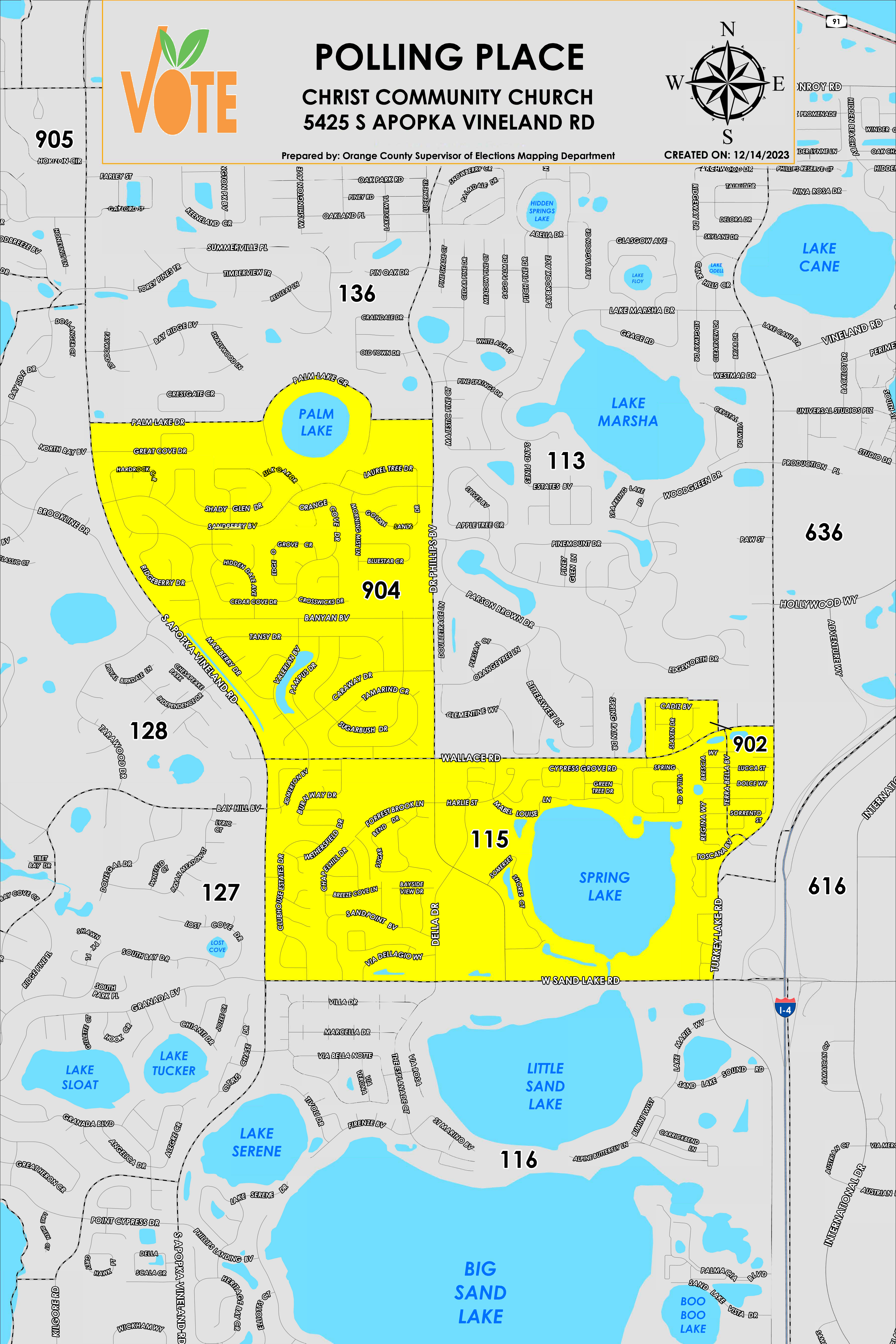


POLLING PLACE

The Polling Place for Precincts 115, 902 and 904 is Christ Community Church at 5425 S Apopka Vineland Road.

Precinct 115 (2024) northern boundary follows along Wallace Road. The western boundary follows along South Apopka Vineland Road. The southern boundary follows along West Sand Lake Road. The eastern boundary follows along Turkey Lake Road.

Precinct 902 (2024) northern boundary follows north of Slaven Drive and Sperone Drive and a section of Wallace Road. The western boundary follows along Terra Bella Boulevard. The southern boundary follows along Piazza Street, and the eastern boundary follows along Turkey Lake Road.

Precinct 904 (2024) northern boundary follows a road combination of Palm Lake Drive, Palm Lake Circle and parallel north of Great Cove Drive. The western boundary follows along South Apopka Vineland Road. The southern boundary follows along Wallace Road, and the eastern boundary follows along Dr. Phillips Boulevard.

Precinct 115 contains sub precincts of:

Precinct 115A is with district assignments of U.S. Congress 11, State Senate 15, State House 44, County Commission 1, and School Board 4.

Precinct 115B is with district assignments of U.S. Congress 11, State Senate 13, State House 44, County Commission 1, and School Board 4.

Precinct 902 contains a sub precinct of:

902A is with district assignments of U.S. Congress 10, State Senate 15, State House 44, County Commission 1, and School Board 4.

902Z is with district assignments of U.S. Congress 10, State Senate 15, State House 44, County Commission 6, and School Board 5.

Precinct 904 contains a sub precinct of:

Precinct 904S is with district assignments of U.S. Congress 10, State Senate 13, State House 44, County Commission 1, and School Board 4.
