

CANDIDATES' QUICK REFERENCE TO 2022 SIGN ORDINANCES

Please refer to each municipality's and Orange County's code(s) for complete information.

APOPKA (407) 703-1704	Maximum size: 32 square feet.	Not to exceed 6 square feet per face.	Shall not place any political sign on any public property or right-of-way, nor on any private property without the express permission of the owner or as may be allowed at public polls.	Beginning after qualifying; remove within 7 days after election.
BELLE ISLE (407) 851-7730	Non-illuminated. Maximum size: 32 square feet. No larger than 4 square feet in area, or located within 40 feet of any other sign. Any sign larger than 4 feet shall be approved by city manager before installation.	2 non-illuminated, no more than 4 feet high, no more than 4 square feet in area. May be installed with express consent of occupant or owner of vacant property.	Shall not be placed on public property – will be removed by city officer.	No more than 90 days before Election Day. Remove within 48 hours after election.
EATONVILLE (407) 623-8900	Non-illuminated. Maximum size: 10 square feet in area, 6 feet in height.	Non-illuminated. Maximum size: 10 square feet in area, 6 feet in height. Must have consent of the owner or occupant of property.	All signs placed in the public right-of-way or on town property shall be subject to immediate removal and disposal by the town. Must not be public property or utility poles.	Beginning 30 days before Election Day. Remove within 10 days after election.
EDGEWOOD (407) 851-2920	Three temporary signs no greater than 6 square feet each in copy area, up to 3 feet in height. Temporary signs must be at least 5 feet from any right-of-way and at least 10 feet from the side and rear property lines.	One temporary freestanding sign, no greater than 6 square feet in copy area, with sign height no greater than 3 feet shall be allowed on the premises at any time.	Non-illuminated. Temporary signs shall be repaired or removed immediately if they become faded, worn, broken, decayed, or otherwise fall into poor repair.	Beginning 60 days before any local, state, or federal election. Remove within 3 days after such election.
MAITLAND (407) 539-6219	Maximum size: 32 square feet and, if displayed as freestanding on the parcel, shall not exceed 12 feet in height.	Shall not exceed 6 square feet in sign area and, if displayed as a freestanding on the parcel, shall not exceed 4 feet in height.	Signs are not subject to permits or fees. For each parcel, one on-site for each candidate and each issue may be displayed along each public street abutting the premises, but shall not be placed in the right-of-way.	Beginning 60 days before Election Day. Removed within 7 calendar days after the election to which it pertains.
OAKLAND (407) 656-1117	Maximum size: 32 square feet per parcel, per endorsed candidate.	Maximum size: 16 square feet per parcel, per endorsed candidate. Permitted with written permission from the affected property owner.	Maximum height: 8 feet. Political signs shall not be placed on any public property or public right-of-way, or on private property without owner's written permission.	Beginning 60 days before Election Day. Remove within 7 days after election.

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OCOE (407) 905-3100	On each property, non-illuminated; maximum size: 32 square feet. No sign exceeding 4 square feet to be within 40 feet of any other campaign sign. Signs larger than 4 square feet require permit/approval.	Maximum of two non-illuminated signs. Maximum size: 4 square feet.	Prohibited on public property and in the right-of-way. Illuminated signs are prohibited. Campaign signs prohibited on vacant property.	Beginning 90 days before Election Day. Remove within 5 days after election.
ORANGE COUNTY (407) 836-3111	Maximum size: 32 square feet per parcel.	Maximum size: 16 square feet per lot. Signs may be erected in residential districts only with the written permission of the landowner.	Maximum height of any political sign: 8 feet. Signs may be permitted in all zoning districts.	Beginning 90 days before Election Day. Remove within 10 days after election.
ORLANDO (407) 246-2686	Non-illuminated; maximum size: 32 square feet on each property.	Two non-illuminated signs. Maximum size: 4 square feet. May be installed by or with the express consent of the occupant of the premises of the owner of vacant property.	Permits may be required. Signs are prohibited on public property and in the right-of-way. See section 64.252, Orlando City Code, for more information.	Remove within 48 hours after election.
WINDERMERE (407) 876-2563	Political and election campaign signs maximum size: 4 square feet. May be displayed by an owner or tenant on their property without a permit.	Political and election campaign signs maximum size: 4 square feet. May be displayed by an owner or tenant on their property without a permit.	Cannot be on town's right-of-way, in roundabouts, parks, or any other public property.	
WINTER GARDEN (407) 656-4111	Maximum size: 32 square feet.	Maximum size: 8 square feet.	City Code Board may assess fines for each sign not removed within 30 days. Campaign signs not permitted on public property.	Remove within 30 days after election.
WINTER PARK (407) 599-3600	Non-illuminated; maximum size: 12 square feet on each property. Such temporary signs shall not individually exceed 4 square feet in area, nor 6 feet in height. Temporary signs promoting an election or political purpose limited to no more than 2 signs per street frontage, and only one per candidate.	Non-illuminated; maximum size: 12 square feet on each property. Such temporary signs shall not individually exceed 4 square feet in area, nor 6 feet in height. Temporary signs promoting an election or political purpose limited to no more than 2 signs per street frontage, and only one per candidate. All signs must be located only on private property with the express permission of the property owner or occupant and shall be located behind the sidewalk, or 10 feet behind the curb or edge of pavement where no sidewalk is present, whichever is greater.	Such temporary signs may be either where an owner or resident is actively attempting to sell or lease such property, either personally or through an agent, or is displaying signage which is supporting an election or political purpose or free expression purpose. With the exception of governmental signs erected by or on the order of a public officer, no sign shall be permitted on public property or over, or across any street or right-of-way, except as may otherwise expressly be authorized.	Beginning 45 days before Election Day. Remove within 7 days of election.
