



**VBM Ballot Request and Early Voting Reports**

**Application to Obtain Vote-by-Mail Ballot Request Information**

**FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF STATE DIVISION OF ELECTIONS**

**Vote-by-mail ballot request information is confidential and exempt from public disclosure under section 101.62(2), Florida Statutes, except to the following persons or entities who may obtain and use it for political purposes only:** 1) Canvassing board, 2) Election official, 3) Political party or official thereof, 4) Registered political committee, 5) Candidate who has filed qualification papers and is opposed in an upcoming election, and 6) Voter (entitled only to access his or her own vote-by-mail ballot request information directly from Supervisor of Elections for the county of residence). Authorization for access is only valid for one general election cycle (i.e., the year in which the scheduled primary and general elections are held). Access automatically expires at the end of the calendar year in which issued. You will have to reapply to renew access (Rule 1S2.043(3)(d), F.A.C.).
